H and I concerns – Much discussion took place over the way H and I is being run. H and I chair member went into Warrick county jail facility alone, and this was discussed. H and I chair admitted mistake and that it wouldn't happen again. Comments were made about H and I not following P and P, including the way it handles money and continually goes over. Concerns over Addicts R Us group donating money to H and I to cover H and I overages.

Comments were also made that "we need to help people that are asking for help and that are showing up to do a job". Wes asked us the ASC to help work towards a solution to these issues. Wes appointed himself Ad-hoc chair for "H and I concerns". Wes asked Tom S. (and others) to write down list of concerns that need to be dealt with at H and I. Ad- Hoc H and I meeting will be held Sunday December 12th at noon. All seemed to be agreement that this was a good idea.

Here are the H and I concerns that were to be addressed at Ad-hoc H and I, the regular H and I and at 1/11 ASC. If you would like to help H and I, show up at the next H and I meeting (see announcement) and/or come to the next ASC!

- 1) Clean time guidelines for facility chairs not being followed according to P and P 2) One person is not allowed to go into lockdown facility 3) Continue to go over on literature spending against group conscience and P and P 4) Clean time requirements for people going into facilities are not being followed 5) Facility chair for Brentwood, James H. will serve until someone who meets the requirements to be facility chair steps up 6) Facility chair for Warrick County jail does not meet the requirements. Dear Area Committee:

Last month's literature activity did not generate any new backorders. A total of \$229.52 worth of literature was ordered by the groups and individuals at last month's ASC meeting and service committees were given a total of \$131.84. It should be noted that the only service committee given literature was the H & I subcommittee and that this overage of \$31.84 was covered by the Addicts R Us group. This made last month's total distribution \$361.36. Since I only had two items we were either low on or out of stock I decided that it would not be prudent or necessary to place a literature order for this month's meeting. So if we do have a large volume of orders this month some groups may experience back orders. If this occurs I will try and do my best to deliver them before next month's business meeting here.

As a friendly monthly reminder Groups may want to keep in mind that many items not stocked by this ASC committee are available and can be purchased on the blank area of the order form and can be ordered here and delivered at the following ASC. I have order forms for anyone interested in seeing additional items available for purchase.

I have heard of no interest in doing committee meetings to review by our fellowship. I will not be scheduling meetings for this review. I would just remind individuals that they are welcome to review the new "Living Clean book project themselves online. The last day for input is December 31st of this year. If you choose to participate the World Service Website is at <http://www.na.org/>. RCM's REPORT TO AREA, December 5, 2010

Region met in the usual place in Owensboro, Kentucky on November 21, 2010. All five areas were represented and all trusted servants occupying those trusted servant positions which were filled attended, including the Treasurer, who explained her recent two absences. I (Jon A.) didn't write a written report on ATRA's behalf to offer at the November Regional meeting, but I think I made some informal, oral announcements and supplied the Secretary, I think, with an updated Meeting List and, perhaps, some flyers to be included in the Regional Minutes.

Open Regional Trusted Servant positions are KRCNA XXVI Chair (South Central Kentucky Area to host), Vice Chair, RD, H&I, PI, P&P, and Literature. It was because it was Mike P.'s last month as Chair, I think I recall, that we voted whether or not Bobby W., then Vice Chair, should be elected Chair, then proceeded to so elect him unanimously.

The Regional Motion 7-5-10, which we originally made at Region and more recently voted at Area to vote in favor of at Region, passed unanimously. This was the motion that Region take a formal inventory. The RCMs present assented to, or voted in favor of, the Secretary's putting together a Regional Questionnaire to facilitate each area in contributing to this Regional Inventory. We are asked to complete this Regional Questionnaire, which is found at the back of the November Regional Minutes, and to bring or send the completed Questionnaire back to Region at its January meeting.

Region will be voting, at its January, 2011 meeting, on Regional Motion 9-8-10, which we made, to have the location of the Regional meeting rotated from one area to another, with the September meeting held at Freedom Between the Lakes. It could be that the GSRs should take back to the Groups this issue so that Area can seek a Group Conscience at its early January meeting concerning how to vote when this Motion comes up at the Regional meeting two weeks later in January, 2011.

PLEASE NOTE that Year End Reports are due at the January 2011 meeting. I reluctantly admit that I haven't yet checked to see for myself whether Regional or Area P&P indicates who in our Area should write the Year End Report. I seem to remember that it was said during the November Regional meeting that there is a web site, perhaps that of World, where one may download or print out a copy of a form for this purpose. I seem to recall in the past thinking at one time that the RCM should write the Year End Report, and at another time that the Area Chair should do so. More will be revealed, I guess.

(RCM's report to Area, December 5, 2011, continued)

I was given a bunch of CDs or DVDs at Region concerning the Southern Zonal Forum (five loose CDs) and one CD (or DVD in a jewel case) concerning WSNAC XXVII, I think, but I haven't had time to review them and attempt to condense them or summarize them. I have them here so that they can be available for review or to be put in the Archives, should that be deemed appropriate.

The RCMs voted unanimously in favor of a Motion made during the November Regional meeting to make an additional donation to World of \$2000 pursuant to reasoning offered by one addict or another that I, for whatever it's worth, thought convincing.

The Regional Treasurer reported a Beginning Balance of \$19,189.20 and an Ending Balance of \$10,940.19, according to my notes, and had at the time of the November Regional meeting made just one deposit, apparently corresponding to a donation made by the Owensboro Area. The Treasurer also gave me what I think is a hand written receipt "for earlier donations," according to my notes, and indicated that something else, I think a more ordinary type of receipt from a receipt book, perhaps for more recent donations by Area to Region, would be forthcoming.

I think that the Pennyriple Area is having a KRCNA Fundraiser on January 15, but if the details were announced orally at Region, I didn't get them written down in my notes. I have brought a number of flyers that I was given concerning various functions in various places in the Region. I also have the Regional Minutes for September and November, at least that part which I received through e-mail, with me in case we didn't bring the September Minutes last month to be included in the Area's Archives.

The next Regional Meeting will be held January 16, 2011 at 1:00 pm in Owensboro, Kentucky. I might mention that my term as RCM expires at the end, I believe, of February, 2011, after which, I would think, our RCMA (Joe G.) would automatically take over as RCM. It could be about time to start looking around for a new RCMA pretty soon.
