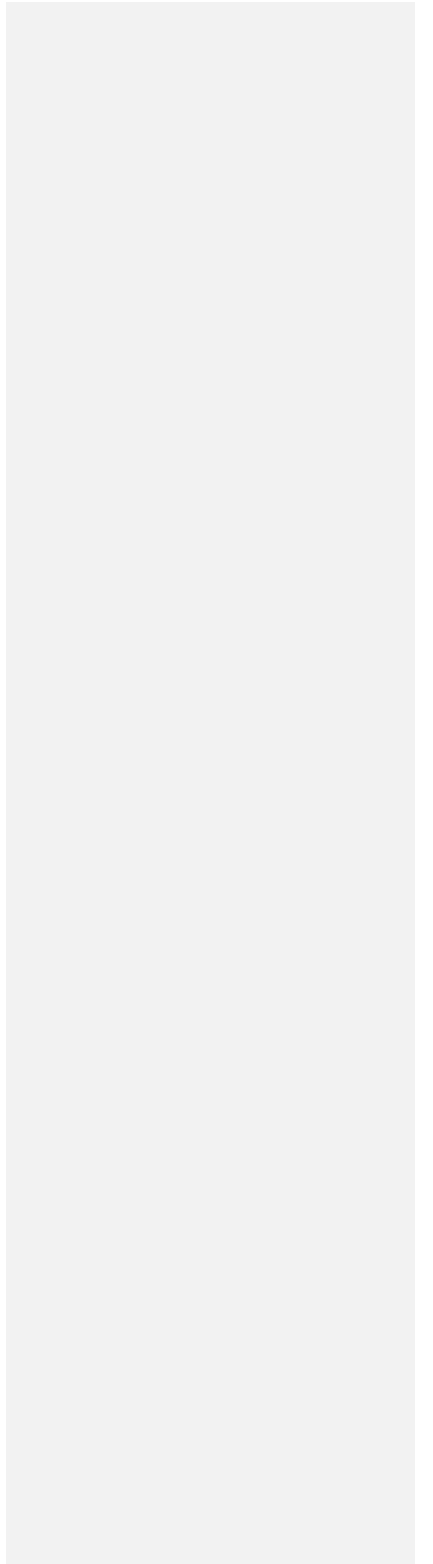

Dear Region,

As chairperson of ATRANA, I am excited to report that our area has experienced incredible growth in 2011. We now have 35 active groups which make up our area from communities in Southwestern Indiana, Southeastern Illinois, and Henderson, Kentucky. It is truly exciting to witness the growth of NA in communities throughout our area. We consistently have 20-25 GSRs representing their groups at our Area Service Committee meetings.

Our Activities subcommittee did an incredible job with area functions and convention fundraisers in 2011. We were able to come together in unity as we celebrated our area's 28<sup>th</sup> birthday last spring. Our annual KRCNA Fundraiser (Halloween function) was again a big hit. We also celebrated the holiday season NA-style with our annual Christmas Marathon. Much appreciation to our Activities Chair and all those dedicated volunteers for their tireless efforts in NA service.

Last summer, our area gratefully hosted the Regional H&I/PR Learning Day. Many volunteers from groups within ATRANA came together to host this function with the purpose of educating us about the role and function of PR and H&I in our region. In the spirit of NA unity and service, members from across the region came together to participate in activities such as a mock phone line and a mock H&I panel. Learning day was a great success! ATRANA once again stepped up in a big way to host a successful regional function while keeping financial prudence at the forefront.

Our H&I subcommittee currently has standing panels in four facilities in our area, three treatment facilities and one county jail. Member participation in both subcommittees has been phenomenal.

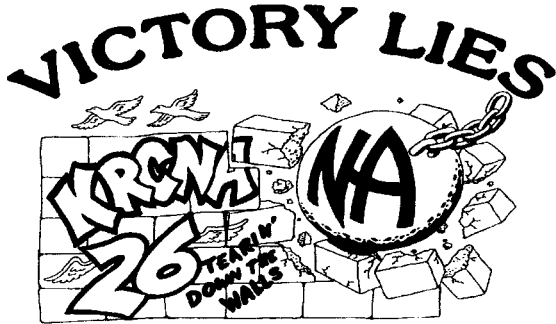


