1. GSR calls the meeting to order with Moment of Silence.
2. Open with the We version of the Serenity Prayer.
3. Read the 12 Traditions.
4. Read the 12 Concepts for Service.
5. Service Prayer ~ by those members present who chose to participate.
“GOD, grant us knowledge that we may serve according to Your Divine precepts. Instill in us a sense of Your purpose. Make us servants of Your will and grant us a bond of selflessness, that this may truly be Your work, not ours ~ in order that, no addict, anywhere, need die from the horrors of addiction.”

7. Identify voting members and set a quorum.
8. Members will please raise hands to be recognized by the GSR to speak.
